It doesn't add up receipt activity

Encourage people to work out how much it would cost them for a week.

Then compare this with the standard rate of Universal Credit of £85 a week for a single person.

Micah 6:8 TT Vision for engaging churches.

(Delivery note: use this slide to explore what we are calling churches to do)

Full text of this verse which inspires our Church Engagement work -

Micah 6:8 **New International Version** 8 He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly[a] with your God.

We see the need to campaign, mercy as kindness and compassion shown by serving your neighbour and walking humbly – being open to learn from and build community with people who are experiencing financial hardship knowing we are all God's children.

Summary:

Act justly – and call for change

Love mercy – while people still face crisis and hardship support your food bank Walk humbly – welcome and give agency to people with lived experience of hardship in your church

The Bible on justice

(Delivery note: explore more of what the bible has to say on justice. Taking part in the GOE campaign is a great way to taking action for justice).

Justice is not only about punishment and retribution. In the Bible it is more often used to talk about the way we live as a society and the way we organise community to make sure people are not left without the essentials they need eg Deuteronomy laws on gleaning and Acts 2.

From GOE Church pack:

Justice is central to the Christian message. Jesus shows us exactly how important and central justice is, as he begins his ministry in Luke 4:18. He publicly reads from the book of Isaiah, where it is written: "the Spirit of the Lord is upon me... to proclaim good news to the poor, bring freedom to prisoners and to set the oppressed free." Jesus also tells us in John 10:10 how he has come so that we may "have life and have it to the full." If we are to all be enabled to live life to the fullest, we must ensure that we have a just society where everyone can at least afford the essentials and not need on the support of a food bank to survive. Throughout the Old Testament, we aren't just challenged to act justly:

we also learn that justice is part of God's nature. "All his ways are just," says Deuteronomy 32:4, while the Psalmist writes that 'righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne' (Psalm 89:14). This justice of God, in caring what happens to all people, leads to many laws and reminders of the importance of supporting each other and building a caring society. People being unable to afford the essentials in this country is an injustice. Our social security system was designed to protect us all when we face hard times, but instead it is pushing people into destitution.

Food banks across the UK are doing all they can to support their communities, but low levels of Universal Credit are pushing more and more people to their doors. We know the solution is for our social security system to be fit for purpose. More than 150,000 of us stood together and signed our petition calling for an Essentials Guarantee.

CHURCHES & FOODBANKS

- ~8,500 total church food bank relationships
- ~20 Churches connected to each food bank
- 98% have Christian trustees/volunteers
- 98% receive food donations from churches
- 77% are in a church building
- 27% supported by churches in campaigning or influencing activity
