... there is a big, transformative moment in this story, when Jesus calls Zacchaeus to come down from the tree. What has Zacchaeus heard or seen which makes him change his ways so dramatically after speaking with Jesus?

Opening Prayer

Generous God,

Thank you that you walk alongside each of us as we explore your Word this Lent. Help me to be curious about what you are showing me. Challenge me through this story from Jesus' life, that I may walk humbly with you towards justice and love.

Our lived experience partner Dee reflects:

“

I've used a food bank myself. I was so scared to go. You are waiting to go in, and you don't know what's going to happen. You're in a long queue and it's very scary. But we've had people who use the food bank, and then come back to volunteer. Or come back with things to donate, because they have been so grateful. They've put their faith in that situation. The fact that Zacchaeus says he will pay back four times as much... his faith was in that moment, so wholeheartedly, a bit like the people who come back to the food bank to say thank you. I'm smiling thinking about it, because it has such an impact. I imagine that's what Zacchaeus felt like.
