Who are we?

Lambeth & Croydon Foodbank have been feeding the local community in South London for over 15 years. We provide 3 days worth of long-life food plus fresh fruit and vegetables to those experiencing food poverty.

We don't just stop there though. We are committed to helping those in poverty, and we have always looked beyond the food parcel to provide signposting help, advice and debt support.

In the last year alone, we fed over 23,500 people. We wouldn't be able to do this without the incredible generosity of our supporters who donate food, money or time.

Why choose us for your corporate event?

Lambeth & Croydon Foodbank is one of the UK's busiest food banks. We are at the forefront of efforts to reduce food insecurity, and volunteering with us offers insight into the issues, a chance to help in a very practical way, and the opportunity to form a stronger bond with work colleagues.

We are based in Tulse Hill, within easy reach of central London: a direct 18 minute train ride from City Thameslink, Blackfriars and London Bridge train stations. We have parking nearby and are just a short bus ride away from Brixton tube station.

Our warehouse is fully accessible, and seated tasks can be provided where required to ensure everyone can take part.

Warehouse Volunteering



Between 5 and 12 colleagues from your organisation can spend a half-day at our Tulse Hill warehouse, making a direct impact by helping to sort donations for our food parcels and supporting the smooth running of our operations.

Sessions typically run from 9.45am-1pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, with some flexibility to accommodate alternative days by prior arrangement.

We ask corporates volunteering with us to make a donation. Demand on our Foodbank is so high that asking corporates to donate is a way of ensuring we have enough food for our clients.

The amount for organisations wanting to volunteer in our warehouse is £100pp and we require a £250 deposit to be paid at the time of booking. If you are a NFP or smaller business, we have special rates so please get in touch to discuss this further.

These amounts are the minimum donation required but of course if you are able to, you could donate more! Everything makes such a difference to our work.

Supermarket Challenge



Our Supermarket Challenge is a perfect team-building activity for larger groups, accommodating 8-20 people.

Working in teams, you'll complete a number of shopping challenges to earn points. You can also grab some bonus points along the way by getting selfies at key Brixton landmarks or points of interest! After your challenge, you'll return to the warehouse for a weigh-in, followed by a short talk about our work and the level of need we're currently seeing.
