“I had recently given birth and was on maternity leave when my husband suffered a stroke. We’d never claimed benefits before and lived on £30 a week until our Universal Credit came through. The foodbank volunteers were absolutely wonderful, even putting in a few treats for the children if they had them, as well as the basics. I felt they understood my situation and supported me; it gave me somewhere where I felt people were on my side. I now have my own business and my partner is working full time again.”

“I became homeless after my relationship broke down as a result of domestic violence. This meant my hours at work were cut down and my debts spiralled. As well as receiving food from the foodbank, I was referred to the Money Advice Project. The lovely people at the foodbank helped me into housing and secured a grant to carpet my new home as the dust from the bare boards was inflaming my Crohn’s Disease. I now have two part-time jobs and have my life back on track. I haven’t needed a food parcel since, but I know who to turn to if I get in trouble again.”
