Supporting local people together

Here at Chichester District Foodbank, we provide emergency food and practical, compassionate support for local people in their hardest moments.

Many people in our community have to make difficult choices about how to cover the essentials. Once priority bills such as rent, energy and council tax are paid, there can be very little left for food. Last year we provided 5,772 emergency food parcels to people across the district, containing not just food, but also other essentials such as pet food, nappies and toiletries.

But our work is about more than putting food on the table. As one person who has used our food bank put it: *"It's not just a food bank, it's a life bank. It's so much more than just food."*

Our aim is to get people the support they need so that they no longer need us. Our team provides a friendly face and a listening ear and can connect people with local partners and our free [Beyond Food: Stronger Futures programme](#) to help with issues like debt, housing, caring responsibilities and mental and physical wellbeing.

The food bank brings people together. Through the groups, friendships form, confidence grows, and people are supported to move forward — not just get by.

I am a single man fallen on hard times but not ever had much support or a positive foundation. I had nothing left and used this food bank, which helped me to foster hope in myself.

I am a solo parent to four children, and to know that my cupboards are stocked, ready for their hungry tummies over the holidays is such a relief.

I was nervous the first time I went to collect my parcel, but I was made to feel welcome and treated kindly and warmly by the whole team.

The food bank has been a genuine lifesaver — not just with food, but with kindness, support, and people who listen.

My husband had a stable job and then he was made redundant. We had to draw on every possible resource. When we didn't have the cash available to purchase food we'd turn to the food bank, and for support — being part of a community was fantastic.

After turning my life around, I wanted to give back to those who helped me and decided to become a volunteer for the food bank. I have the privilege of meeting others; I get to hear their stories and support them using my own experiences. I feel so lucky and fulfilled to be able to help in any way I can.
