We hope you will find the following information useful for informing and engaging people with your collection. We are here to support you if you need anything, so please do not hesitate to contact us.

What to Collect

Our Harvest appeal poster shows the items that we most urgently need for you to circulate so everyone knows what to give. We have also created a shopping list which you might find easier to hand out. You can ask people to donate shopping bags with their items – bags being another much-needed item at food banks!

Food banks work with non-perishable food items (tinned and dried goods), which do not spoil. All items should be unopened, in date and in good condition. We also accept toiletries and hygiene products, helping people in crisis to maintain dignity.

Delivery or Collection

We'd be incredibly grateful if you were able to deliver your donations directly to our warehouse. We're open to receive donations on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday between 9.00 am and 2.00 pm. If you'd prefer to drop off outside these hours, just get in touch - we're happy to arrange a suitable time.

If you'd like us to collect your donation, please contact us as early as possible so we can schedule a pickup. Kindly note that this may require storing the food at your premises for a few days until collection is arranged.

Directions to our Warehouse

- Unit 36 Upper, Albion Mills, Albion Road, Greengates BD10 9TQ
- Turn off the A657 onto Albion Road.
- Enter Albion Mills (BizSpace) via the top entrance by 'Shimu'.
- Our unit is the second building on your left (3 grey pointed roofs).
